

TOWN OF BEDFORD
CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING MINUTES
August 19, 2021

ROLL CALL & QUORUM: A meeting of the Cemetery Trustees was held on August 19, 2021 at the carriage shed, 11 Church Road. Present were: David Bailey (Chairman), Steve Wiggin, and Art Alden (Secretary). Also present was State Senator Denise Ricciardi.

Chairman Bailey Called the meeting to order at 2:04 PM.

NEW BUSINESS:

a. Cemetery Signage

We have decided to go with the same design and company as the Town of Merrimack used for their cemeteries. We will be doing only the Center, Joppa, & Beals at this point.

With regards to the granite posts. Trustee Wiggin will contact Peter Barbuto to get some quotes.

b. Hilltop Irrigation

The current lines have been damaged due to grave digging. The "alley way" markers were put in the wrong place. We have received estimates as high as \$6K to repair or replace. No decision has been made at this time

c. Center Cemetery Entrance Upgrades

Trustee Wiggin met with of members of the Bedford Garden Club to see if their organization had any interest in doing some plantings. They will present it to the club and get back to us with an estimate of cost.

OLD BUSINESS:

a. Repair of Historic Stones

Chairman Bailey reminded the Trustees that we had an obligation to continue maintenance of historic stones as a result of the transfer of funds from the Friends of Bedford Cemeteries. Trustee Wiggin took the action to put together a plan to meet our obligation.
