News & Noteworthy:

- 1) Town/School Election will be held on Tuesday, March 8th with the polls open at the High School from 7 AM to 7 PM. Absentee ballots are available at the Town Office Building until 5 PM on Monday, March 7th. Absentee Ballots must be delivered in person to the town Office Building by 5 PM on March 7th, or received in the Town Office Building by US Mail by 5 PM on March 8th. Sample Ballots are available on the Town Website.
- 2) The last day to register to vote or to make name and address changes prior to the March 8th Election is Saturday, February 27, 2016. The Town Office Building will be open extra hours on Saturday, February 27th from 11:00 AM to Noon. Residents may also register to vote at the polls on Election Day.
- 3) The Town Budgetary Town Meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 9th at the High School Auditorium at 7 PM. - 5) Members First Credit Union on Route 101 is now open.

- 1) Library HVAC/Geothermal The well drilling contractor will be mobilizing to the site over the next two weeks with an expected March 15th first day of drilling.
