### **Project Updates:**

- 1) 2019 Roads Program The Department of Public Works has started work on Gage Road and the Donald Street project will start in approximately two weeks. Back River Road, Tirrell Road, and Smith Road will be paved early in the season but no date has been set.
- 2) Transfer Station The project to move the entrance and scale is working through the permit process and was presented to the Conservation Commission for their required recommendation to NHDES on the necessary wetland impact permit.

- 3) The Document Management team has made a final recommendation on a vendor and we are analyzing how to move forward as the cost to fully implement the program for all users is beyond what is currently budgeted.
- 4) Personnel: I am pleased to announce that long time patrolman Eli Krause has been named as our new SRO to replace William "Spike" Donahue who announced his retirement last month. Fire Lieutenant Mark Shatney has announced his retirement after a long and distinguished career. It is anticipated that a promotion will be made from within the department to fill the Lieutenant position. Firefighter/paramedics Mike Kelly and Chris Collins are resigning from the department to pursue other opportunities. Interviews will be conducted in the next few days for our open Accountant position for which we have received approximately 50 applications. Applications are being accepted for our seasonal positions at the pool, camp, and Library, and full time positons of Police Officer, Firefighter, Communications Specialist, Equipment Operator, Truck Driver, Program Manager, and part time positions of Administrative Technician.
