

DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

Bedford, NH – March 14, 2023 Charter Commission

669:19 Nomination: Non-partisan Ballot System. In a town which has adopted the non-partisan ballot system as provided in RSA 669:13, all candidates shall file a declaration of candidacy with the town clerk during the filing period for Charter Commission candidates. Such filing period shall begin on the fourth Wednesday before the election and end on the Friday of the following week before the town election.

Filing period for the March 14, 2023 election begins

February 15th 2023 and ends at 5:00 pm February 24th 2023

As per RSA 669:19 candidates who file on the last day of the filing period shall do so in person before the town clerk.

Political Sign Reminder

1. The provisions of RSA 664:17 shall be strictly enforced.
2. No political advertising shall be placed on or affixed to any public property, utility poles, highway signs or private property without the owner's consent. Political advertising may be placed within state-owned rights-of-way as long as the advertising does not obstruct the safe flow of traffic and the advertising is placed with the consent of the owner of the land over which the right-of-way passes.
3. No political signage shall be allowed to be installed or maintained on any town owned lands or the rights of way adjacent to town owned property unless specifically approved by or requested to be installed by vote of the Town Council.
4. Individuals running for local office shall be provided a copy of the policy at the time of registering for the election.
