The Town of Bedford, NH is holding its Annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day on Saturday, July 15, 2023, from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM, at the Bedford Highway Garage, located at 19 Chubbuck Road, Bedford, NH.

This is a one-day event for Bedford residents to dispose of unwanted household hazardous waste. **Your vehicle must have a valid Bedford Transfer Station Sticker to participate in this event. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

From the Workbench

- Adhesives
- Oil Based Caulking
- *Oil Based Paint/Stains
- Paint Thinners
- Photography Chemicals
- Spray Paints

From the Kitchen

- Household Cleaning Solvents
- Oven Cleaners

From the Shed

- Autobody Repair Products
- Lighter Fluids
- Moth Balls
- Pool Chemicals
- Wood Preservatives

For Lawn/Garden

- Bug Spray
- Fertilizers Containing Pesticides
- Pesticides, herbicides, fungicides
- Weed Killer

NOT ACCEPTED

- Asbestos
- Commercial Grade/Cleaning Products
- Explosives (ammunition)
- Fireworks
- Industrial Waste
- Radio Active Materials
- Road Flares
- Building materials and air conditioners
- Prescription drugs
- Printer Cartridges

**Latex paint is NOT accepted at HHWD, but oil-based paints are. Latex paint can be discarded with your regular trash once it's been thoroughly dried.*

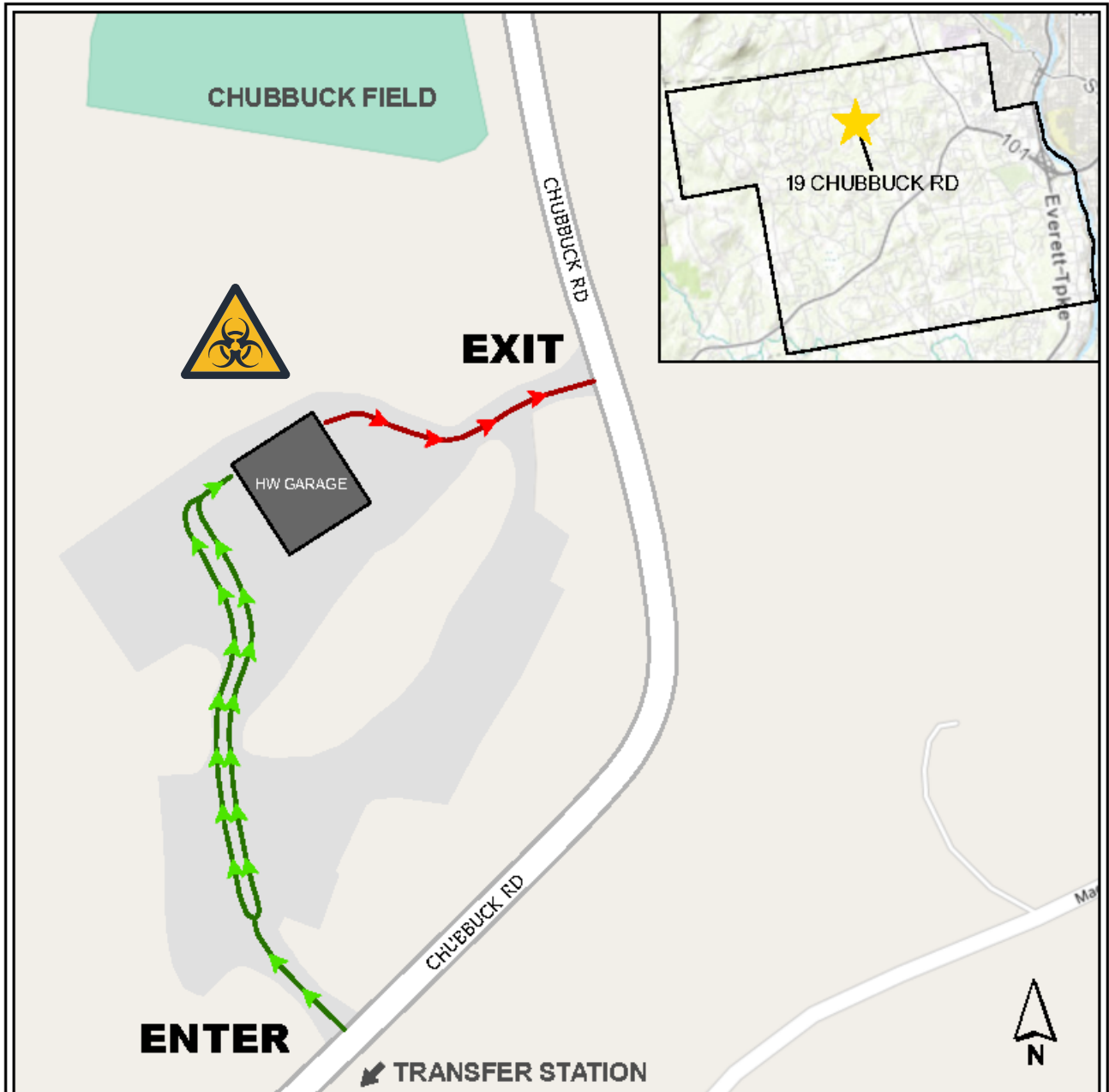
